1. William *helps* his father with the housework every day.
2. Ivan always works out in the gym after school.
3. She is never late for school.

5. My mother often *prepares* meals for us.

7. She often goes to the library to check out books. (借書)

He *does* exercise in the morning.  
Exercising in the morning is a good habit.  
It is a good habit to exercise in the morning.

2. My mother is *busy* (with, **cooking**, making) dinner. (忙著做晚餐)

3. He has no time for TV. He doesn't have time **to watch TV**. (沒時間看電視)

4. I like **to play** sports after school. (喜歡運動)

### C. Reading and Writing (閱讀與寫作)

1. Sophia cleans her room **every other** day. (每隔一天).

Sophia cleans her room **every two** days.

2. Customer(顧客): "**May** I take a look **at** this watch?"

Clerk(店員): "Sure. Here you are."

3. The fourth piece of art **shares the same** idea **as** the third **one**.

4. He **shows** me **around**.
