Sarah: I love the idea! I will do this at home with my children. Thanks for sharing (分享) this bread idea with me, Lisa!

English Explanation:

The correct answer is C: $c \rightarrow a \rightarrow b \rightarrow d$, and here's why:

1. Step c: Prepare some bread and spread.

This is always the first step — you need materials before starting.

2. Step a: Draw on the bread.

Drawing is done while the bread is still soft. It's difficult to draw on toast because it's hard and may break. *Many toast art tutorials also show that the design is drawn before toasting.*

3. Step b: Toast the bread.

After drawing, the bread is toasted. This step helps bring out the color and finalize the artwork.

4. Step d: Eat the bread.

Naturally, eating comes last.

Although the dialogue does not state the order directly, it implies that the

drawing is done before toasting by saying things like “put some chocolate on it” or “draw on the bread.” These actions are easier to do on soft bread, not on hard toast — this must be understood through logic or experience.

正確答案是 C：c → a → b → d，原因如下：

1. 步驟 c：準備麵包與抹醬。

這一定是第一步，因為需要材料才能開始。

2. 步驟 a：在麵包上作畫。

畫圖是在麵包還軟的時候做的。如果先烤，吐司會變硬，難以作畫且容易碎。**許多吐司畫的教學也都是先畫再烤。**

3. 步驟 b：將麵包烤過。

畫完之後再去烤，這樣可以讓顏色或線條更清楚，呈現出藝術效果。

4. 步驟 d：吃掉麵包。

最後當然是享用美味的吐司藝術。
