In 2024, Jerry was already 70 years old. He knew he had to do something for the Dream River. He began standing on the street corner and handing out flyers.

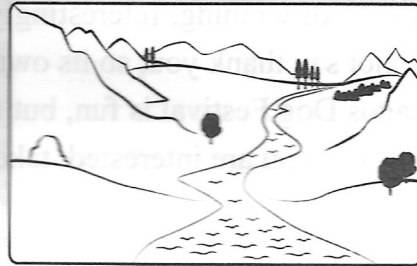

Do you love dogs? If you do, you will enjoy the Lagos Dog Festival in Nigeria. It is a fun day for dogs and their owners!

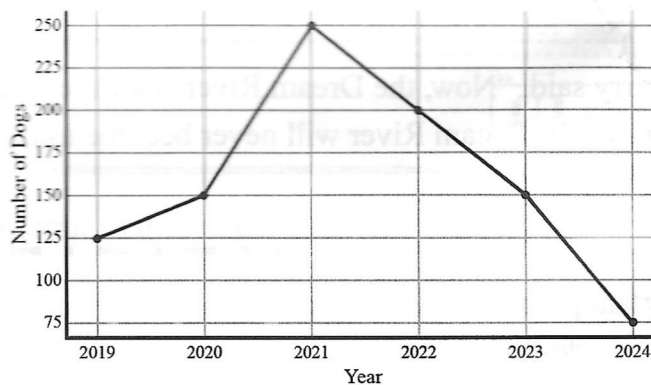
It is not easy to have this festival in Nigeria because many people there keep dogs to guard homes, not as pets. Some people even sell dogs or eat dog meat.

Jackie Idimogu, an animal lover from Nigeria, wanted people to be kind to animals. In 2019, she started the Lagos Dog Festival. To join, dogs must be friendly, clean, and healthy. Every year, people at the festival pick Dog of the Year. The festival also has fun games and shows for dogs and their owners. It helps people learn more about caring for pet dogs.

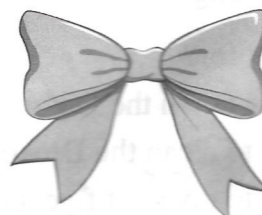

Bird World

One of the most special birds in the bird world is the crossbill. These small birds can 40 . They are good at this because they need to find food—the seeds from pinecones. Their strong feet help them move easily on the tree and get the seeds.

Male crossbills 41 female crossbills. Males have bright red or orange feathers, but females have green or yellow feathers. The bright colors of the males help the females notice them.



One interesting thing is that some male crossbills are redder than others. A report shows that the more a male crossbill 42 , the redder its feathers become. Exercise makes a male crossbill look redder.

43 , crossbills make different sounds to “talk” to each other. Their calls are important, especially when they are looking for a partner. Different groups have different ways of calling. These sounds help them stay together and call their young.
